

## Connecting to KSU WiFi on a Google Pixel

The following guide walks you through connecting to the KSU WiFi using a Google Pixel.

**Note:** This guide was written using a Google Pixel XL on Android version 7.1.2.

1. To access the *WiFi Settings* from your home screen, swipe **up** from the bottom of the screen.

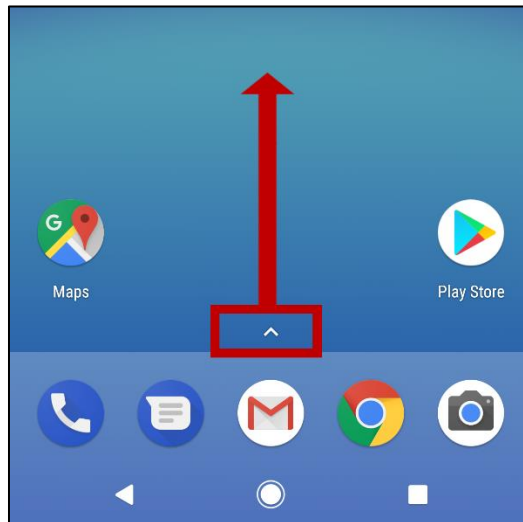


Figure 1 – Swipe Up

2. A list of apps will be displayed. Tap the **Settings** icon.

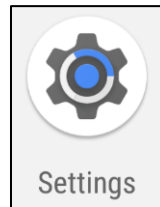


Figure 2 - Tap the Settings Icon

3. The *Settings* will open. Tap **Wi-Fi**.

4. A list of access points will be displayed. Select **KSU**.

5. The *KSU network* window will open. Enter the following settings:
  - a. *EAP method*: Select **PEAP** from the drop-down menu (See Figure 5).
  - b. *Phase 2 authentication*: Select **MSCHAPV2** from the drop-down menu (See Figure 5).
  - c. *Server CA certificate*: Select **Do not validate** from the drop-down menu (See Figure 5).
  - d. *Identity*: Enter your **NetID** (See Figure 5).
  - e. *Password*: Enter your **KSU password** (See Figure 5).
  - f. Click **Connect** (See Figure 5).

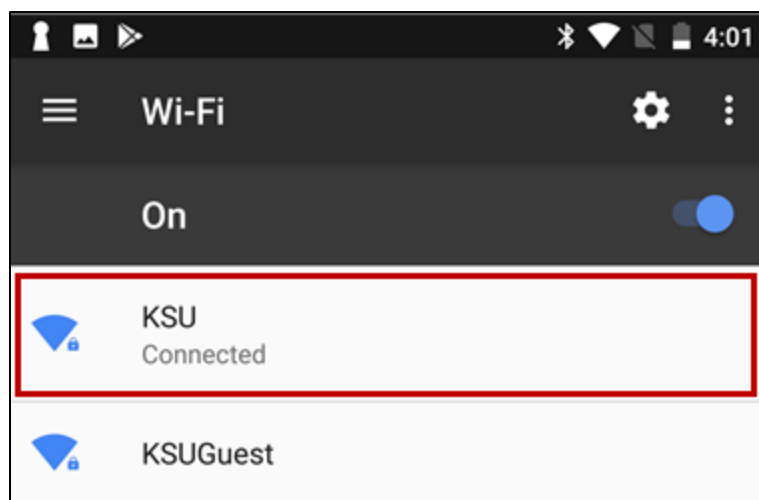


Figure 6 - Connected to KSU Wifi
