

KSU VPN Client Installation & Campus Network Connection using an iOS Device

The following describes how install and use the GlobalProtect agent to connect remotely to the campus network using a VPN connection on an iPad or other iOS device.

Note: This documentation was created using an iPad Air 2 (version 11.2.6).

Installing the GlobalProtect Agent on Your iPad/iOS Device

1. Tap **App Store** on your device.

2. Search for **Global Protect**.

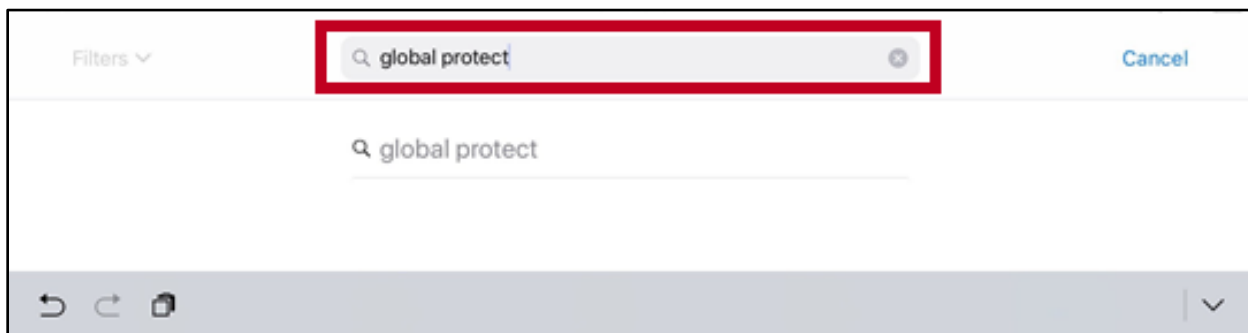


Figure 2 - Search for GlobalProtect

3. Under the application name, tap **Install**.

4. Once installed, tap **Open**.

5. The *GlobalProtect enable VPN* window appears. Tap **OK**.

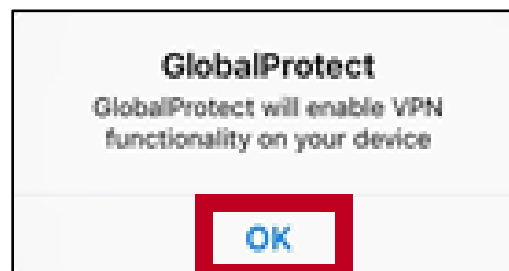


Figure 5 - Enable VPN

- In the *Server* field, enter **vpn.kennesaw.edu** (See Figure 7).

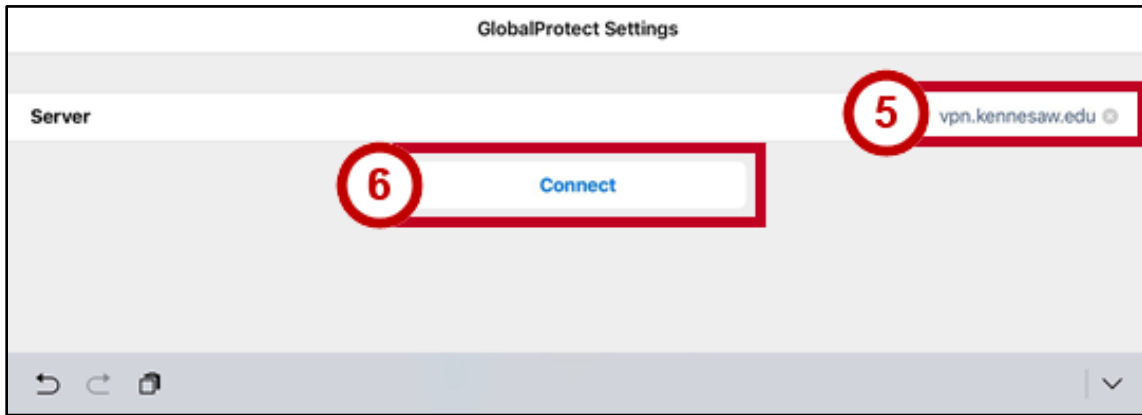


Figure 6 - Connect to VPN

- Tap **Connect** (See Figure 6).

- In the *Account* field, enter your **NetID** (See Figure 7).
- In the *Password* field, enter your **password**. (See Figure 7).
- Tap **OK** (See Figure 7).

- You have successfully connected to the KSU VPN.

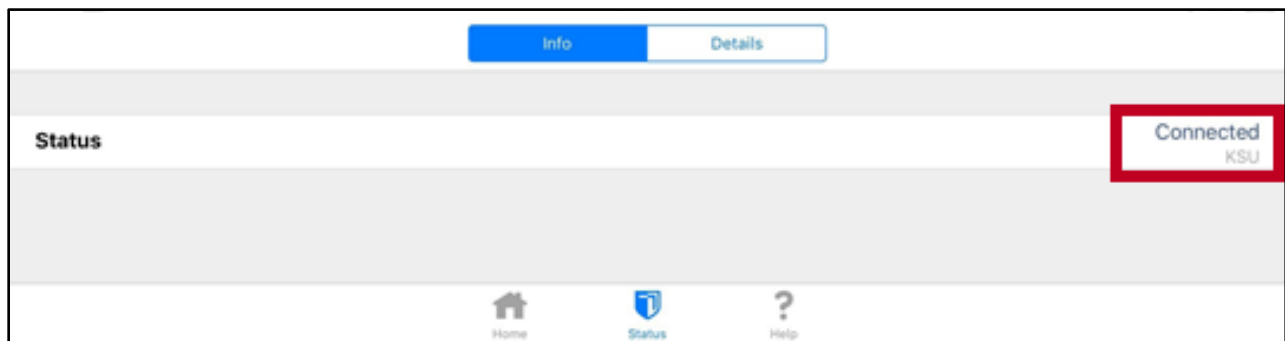


Figure 8 - Connected

Accessing Campus Services

Rather than connecting to your office computer, you may wish to use your browser to access commonly used KSU applications and services that can only be accessed while on the KSU network. The KSU VPN serves as an entry point. The following instructions describe how to access the *Campus Intranet* page.

To access the KSU Campus Intranet site, use the following steps:

Note: The Remote Desktop Connection is not needed to access the campus intranet as long as you are connected to the KSU VPN.

1. After connecting to the KSU VPN, open your **preferred browser** (i.e., Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome).
2. Navigate to <https://campus.kennesaw.edu/>.
3. The *Campus Intranet* website will open. Click on the **link** of your choice to access the desired service.

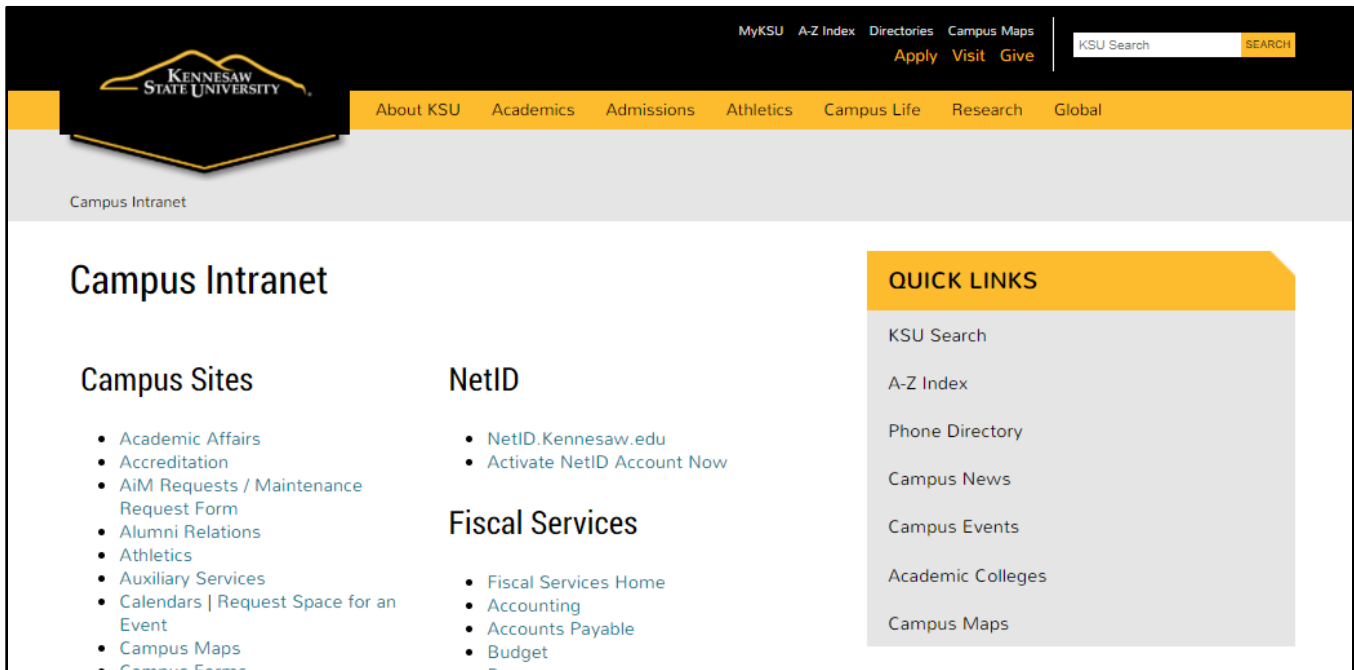


Figure 11 - Campus Intranet

Disconnecting from the VPN Connection

1. To disconnect from the network, tap the **GlobalProtect App**.

2. The Status window appears. Tap **Home**.

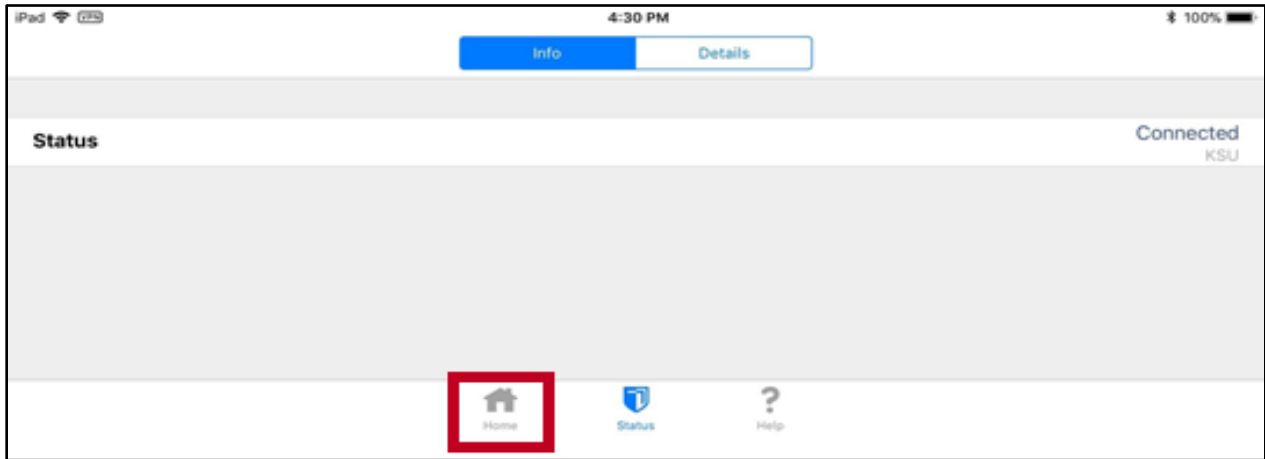


Figure 13 - Tap Home

3. Tap **Connection**.

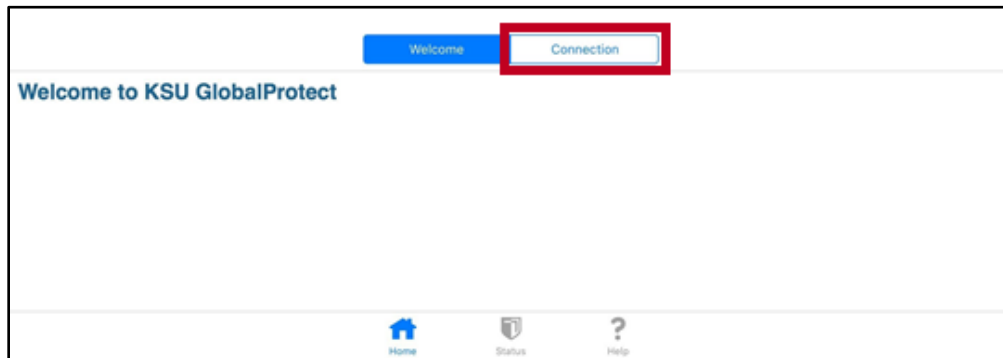


Figure 14 - Tap Connection

4. Tap **Disconnect**.

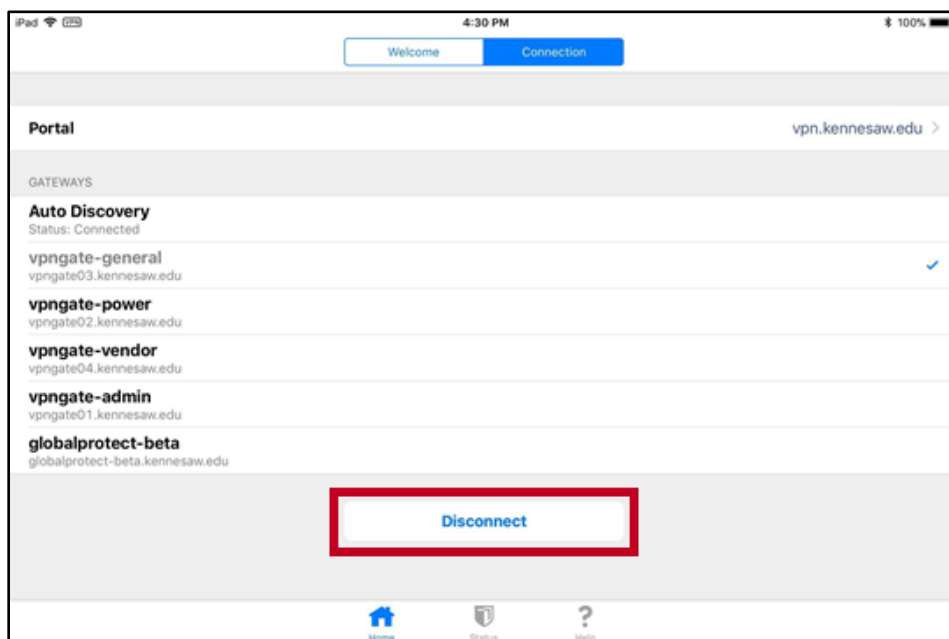


Figure 15 - Tap Disconnect

6. You are now disconnected from the KSU VPN.

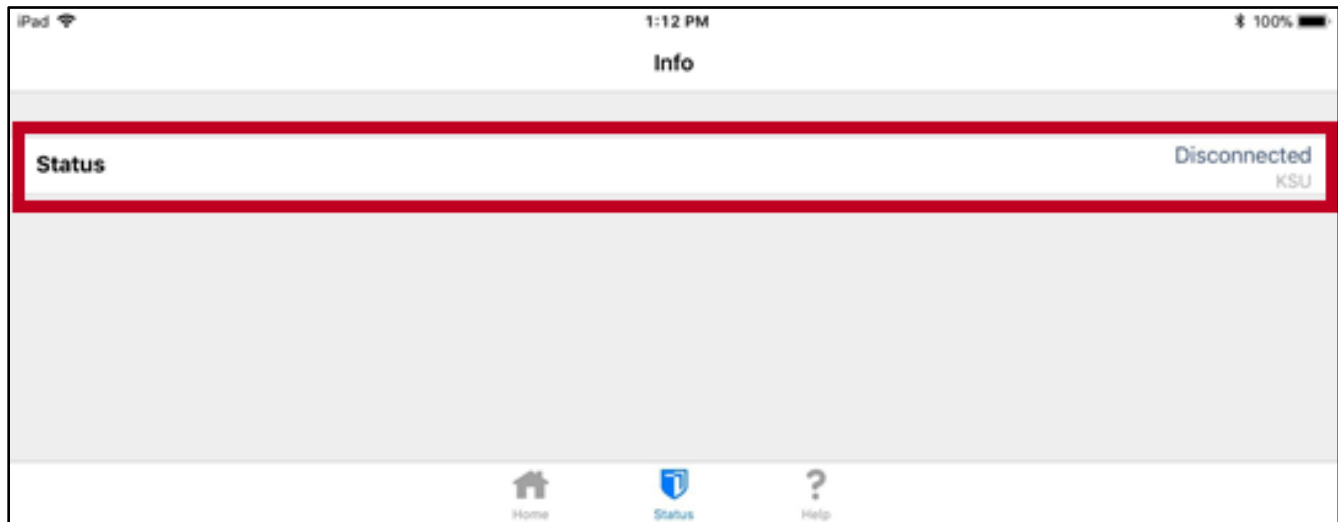


Figure 16 - Disconnected from KSU VPN
