


The iPad mini 5 is an Apple tablet. It has a capacity of 64 GB, a 7.9-inch retina display.

FAQs

How do I turn the iPad mini On/Off?

To turn the iPad mini on, press and hold the top button until the Apple logo appears on the screen. To turn it off, press and hold the top button until the screen display goes dark.

Note: If the device is already on, simply pressing the top button without holding it down will either put the device to sleep or wake it up. If a passcode is set up, the device will lock once it goes to sleep. You will need to enter the passcode after pressing the top button to unlock the device.

How do I know if the iPad mini is charged?

The battery icon in the upper-right corner of the status bar shows the battery level or charging status.

Note: If the device is too low on power, an image of a nearly depleted battery may display on the screen instead. If this occurs, the display may be blank for up to two minutes before the low-battery image appears. The device may need to charge for up to ten minutes before you will be able to use it.

How do I charge the iPad mini?

To charge the iPad mini, connect the device to a power outlet using the included cable and power adapter or connect the included cable to the USB port of another device.

Note: If iPad mini is connected to a device that is turned off, it will not charge.

How do I adjust the speaker the Volume/Speaker Controls?

Use the volume buttons on the side of the iPad mini to adjust the volume of sound from media and alerts.

Note: To mute the device, press and hold the down volume button until the sound off icon appears.

How do I turn my microphone and camera on/off?

The microphone and camera are accessed through the Settings menu. They can also be accessed by individual apps.

How do I take a screenshot?

To take a picture of what is currently displayed on the screen, hold down both the **On/Off Sleep/Wake** button and the **Home/Touch ID sensor** button simultaneously until the screen flashes.

Note: Screenshots you take on your device can be found in the *Photos* app.
